Toledo GROWs Best Practices— Tending a Garden



Commercial seed packets have a “packed for” year on them. Packets that are stored in a dry place, at room temperature, and out of direct sunlight can usually last 1 to 4 years past that date. Avoid storing seeds in damp areas or in temperatures below 45 degrees or above 75 degrees.

1 Year	Onion, Oregano, Parsnip
1-2 Years	Corn, Dill, Endive, Leek, Lettuce, Okra, Parsley, Pepper, Spinach
2-3 Years	Arugula, Asparagus, Beans, Broccoli, Chinese Cabbage, Carrot, Celery, Fennel, Kohlrabi, Mustard, Peas
3 Years	Artichoke, Beets, Brussel Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Swiss Chard, Chicory, Eggplant, Kale, Pumpkin, Radish, Rutabaga, Sorrel, Summer Squash, Winter Squash, Tomato, Turnip, Watermelon, Zucchini
4 Years	Collards, Cress, Cucumber, Melon
