Commercial seed packets have a "packed for" year on them. Packets that are stored in a dry place, at room temperature, and out of direct sunlight can usually last 1 to 4 years pas that date. Avoid storing seeds in damp areas or in temperatures below 45 degrees or above 75 degrees.
